



CONCESSIONAIRE'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supply and erect booth
- Supply own extension cords where hydro is required
- Dismantle and remove the day after Regatta (August 4th, 2009)

BOOTH SIZE

- Each booth has ten foot frontage
- Rear extends to the access road
- Each lot has a five foot walk are on the left or right

CONCESSION CARDS

Concession cards will be distributed to each concessionaire for the sole purpose of identifying your vehicle for park entrance when re-supplying your booth.

CONCESSION OPERATION HOURS

Concession hours of operation are limited from 10:00 AM to 2:00 AM

OPENING DAY – SATURDAY, AUGUST 1ST, 2009

Please ensure that your booth is supplied and your vehicle removed from park premises before 9:45 AM on Saturday. We also ask that you try to re-supply your booth when crowds are limited-early morning and between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM.

GARBAGE

Wet garbage should be placed in garbage containers supplied by the park. Dry garbage must be removed from the front of the booths and should be placed in the rear of the booth for removal on a daily basis.
